This program will be administered by the new Office of Federal Contract Assistance to Women Business Owners (CAWBO), which is part of SBA's Office of Government Contracting. CAWBO's mission is to increase Federal contracting opportunities for women-owned small businesses (WOSBs) and to increase the number of WOSBs that successfully compete in the

Federal marketplace. The first EDWOSB set aside contracts awarded through the program are expected to be seen sometime in the fourth quarter of fiscal year.
